Its inclusion on the list comes from the mention of Avalda in the Domseday Book and its appearance as a separate place in the 1924 translation of the Domesday Book for Cornwall. [1] Since this translation, the Phillimore edition of Domesday has now identified the settlement as Levalsa, and it is therefore listed here as doubtful. [2] There is no indication of why the settlement appears as Avada rather than Avalda in the 1968 Gazetteer. Appears in the Gazetteer of Deserted Medieval Villages known in 1968.
