Description	Ildeberga is mentioned in the Domesday Book, not as an entry itself, but as the location where Abbot Walter proved his right to land in Bengeworth in Worcestershire. [1] It is only further recorded two times in 969 and in the thirteenth century, and is located in the parish of Evenlode but has not been firmly established. [2] The evidence suggests that it is doubtful there was ever a settlement. Appears in the Gazetteer of Deserted Medieval Villages known in 1968.
